PHOTOG-BUDDY is a project of personal development for a group of bereaved teenagers aged 13 to 19, co-organised by The HKFMS Foundation Limited and Togetherness. Through 8 weeks of learning photography techniques and joining outdoor practices, participants were emotionally guided to build a healthy personality and to reform their spiritual direction. The workshop, which is eight 3-hour sessions (2pm to 5pm on Saturdays), has been successfully completed in July and August. Voluntary tutors taught photography techniques and self-expression skill as well as tips to define self-oriented theme on photography. Therefore, the bereaved teenagers could leave the past behind, cherish the present and look forward to the future.

The exhibition aims at encouraging the public awareness on caring those adolescents, thereby assisting them to overcome the psychological barrier. Please support the bereaved teenagers' efforts not only on their photos but also braving adversity.

「光影同行」由香港醫學組織聯會基金及同行力量合辦,是爲十三至十九歲正面對喪失親人的少年所提供之個人成長支援項目。通過八星期的攝影技巧課堂學習和外影活動,參加者從中得到情感上適切的關顧和開導、建立健康正面的人際關係及重塑自己的人生方向。攝影工作坊已於七月及八月舉行,每節三小時共八節(下午二時至五時),義工導師教授攝影技巧及自我表達的學習、個人導向之專題攝影,藉此爲失親青少年「回望過去、肯定現在、展望將來」。

而是次攝影作品展是將學生們的攝影作品展示給大眾,希望透過各界合力 喚起社會關懷,幫助這一羣失親少年度過心理難關,同時能感受他們從活 動中的得益和成長,支持他們珍惜和正面地面對生命的每一天。


